Roof Repairs After the Hurricane

It has been just over six weeks since Irma has moved through the Central Florida area. As I am sure you are aware, the entire State of Florida was affected by this massive storm. There is damage from Key West to Jacksonville. Vendors who would normally be available to do repairs within 1-2 business days

after receiving our phone calls are now a minimum of 2-3 weeks out. Some supplies for repairing damaged buildings are still hard to come by, e.g. roofing shingles, as they are being diverted to Houston, Key West and Puerto Rico.

Although we were hit by Hurricane Irma, we will all need to be patient as the other parts of the country start their recovery from their disasters as well. Hurricane Harvey was a once in a 1,000 year rain event that inundated Houston and east Texas under 50" of rain in 5 days. Hurricane Irma was the most massive hurricane to ever come out of the Atlantic Ocean Basin as it mercilessly tore through the U.S. Virgin Islands, partially struck Puerto Rico then made its way to Florida. Hurricane Maria was a monster storm as it devastated the crown jewel of the Caribbean, Puerto Rico.

During Hurricanes Charlie, Francis and Jean in 2004, Central Florida was hit three times in one year and the country poured resources into Florida to help with our recovery. Even with all of the extra resources, it took well over a year for everything to be put back to a new form of normal. Now we must share these resources with our fellow Americans in Puerto Rico,

Orange County Bulk Pick Up Instructions

Inder the Orange County Curbside Collection program, garbage, recycling, and yard waste are each picked up only one time per week.week.

Per the documents of your community, we are asking that you please do not place these carts near or on the street on days when you do not have a scheduled pickup. Please keep them by your home and behind your storage area fence if you have one.

In addition, if you have any large items that need to be picked up that will not fit in the new garbage bin, please contact the County to arrange pick-up. *Do not* place bulk items in the street or in your parking spots and leave them there. You must email or call the county at: Solid.Waste@ocfl.net (include your name, street address, contact information, and the item(s) that you want collected) or call the Solid Waste Hotline at 407-836-6601 to arrange for pickup. Large items include furniture, appliances, mattresses, automobile tires (limit 4), and rear-projection televisions. Limit large items to three cubic yards (about one small pickup truckload) per household per week.
